The Project

As a platform, we provide multiple APIs to expose our features to customers. While we provide both <u>SOAP</u> and <u>REST</u> interfaces, a lot of customers still prefer to code using our SOAP API. In order for them to do that, we provide a <u>WSDL</u> file that they then use to generate a jar file that gets imported into their apps.

This project will consist of writing automation to authenticate to one of our existing public environments, download the WSDL file for a specific API, generate its jar file and publish it to a public artifact repository like Maven Central or Nexus.

Core functionality: Java, Maven, Bash, XML SCM: Git to manage the project on github.
